Highlights & Milestones

The first 7 months of this year have been marked by powerful milestones as lives continue to be transformed-reflecting a growing hunger to connect with God and each other.

170 baptisms so far in 2025, including 49 during our Kid's **Beach Baptism**

50 new members have joined the **CLC family since January**

Average weekly attendance: In-person: 1,299 up by 3% Online stream: 565 | up 9.5%

Focused on 4 biblical prayers that guide our purpose & community life.




Taught on communion, baptism, & community values.

Connections & Hospitality



Connections & Hospitality are the heartbeat of our church community, creating a welcoming space where every person feels seen, valued, and encouraged to take their next step in faith and belonging.

Hospitality Team served weekly: 230+ cups of coffee & cappuccino, 310 bottles of water & dozens of snacks.

Connection Team connected: An average of 107 volunteers used the Volunteer Room each Sunday, up by 65%.

Connected 40+ new individuals to serve alongside ministry leaders.

98 guests visited the Connection Carts for next steps & information.







Adult Ministries



Our multigenerational groups span generations, bringing together members from age 17 to 92, each contributing unique wisdom, energy, and perspective to our shared mission.

93% of group participants reported spiritual & relational growth.

762 people connected through small groups

110 groups met during the 2024-2025 academic year.

Two-thirds of participants experienced real-life transformation through their group involvement.







Children's Ministry



Our Children's Ministry is thriving through strong connections built both during Sunday gatherings & midweek activities, as well as an impactful VBS.

726 children attended VBS; 283 1st time participants

300 volunteers served at VBS; 97 1st time volunteers

49 children were baptized at the Children's Beach Baptism Bash.

269 children attend the Children's Ministry weekly on Sundays.

129 children are enrolled at Connect Christian Academy; 79% are full-time students













Youth Ministry

EMERGE, the Youth Ministry of Community Life Church, exists to connect students to Jesus Christ and to help them develop their own faith story which will lead them to live out the Gospel every day.

10 students & 4 leaders served in Tuskegee, Alabama by leading a day camp for children & working on construction projects for homeowners!

27 students and 6 adults attended Oakwood Summer Camp & learned that they are seen, known, loved, & chosen!

43 students on average attended midweek over the last school year & deepened their knowledge of the Bible!

109 students on average attended on Sunday Morning & grew in their relationship with Jesus!







Disability Ministry



We began this year prayerfully leaning into God's calling for this ministry. We remain confident in His provision, hopeful for the future, and deeply grateful for all who have prayed, served, and supported this ministry along the way.

A major milestone was hosting our first in-house prom, welcoming 75 guests & supported by 100+ volunteers. The intimate setting made space for deep connections & lasting joy.

During VBS, God opened doors for inclusion as we supported several students with 1:1 buddies & launched our first sensory room.

50+ individuals have stepped up, ready to be equipped & serve in various volunteer roles.









Behind the Scenes

Support teams are vital because they keep ministries running smoothly, ensure safety, and help the whole church thrive.

The Leadership Board, Finance, Personnel, & Trustee Committees collaborate strategically to ensure the church's long-term health & growth.

Security & Medical Teams provide year-round protection & peace of mind.

The Parking Team greets & guides guests each Sunday with smiles & efficiency.

Gardens & Grounds Day brought 100+volunteers together to beautify our campus.

The Garden Team serves regularly to maintain landscaping & create a peaceful environment.

Worship, Production, Greative Communications


Every Sunday and throughout the week, the Creative Arts team brings worship to life through music, production, and visual storytelling

Creative Teams produced over 15,000 original assets (photos, videos, series branding).

Monthly Training Development Days build team skill, unity, & creativity.

Missions

CLC made a global impact—kids collected coins for school supplies and a motorcycle in Zimbabwe, youth served on mission trips, and adults led projects bringing help and hope locally and beyond.

Honduras:

 240 children received free Christian education & 28 orphans found a loving home.

Zimbabwe

 Over 30,000 people access clean water daily & 800 children are now protected by a new school fence.

Locally:

- Hot meals were served to hundreds facing homelessness through Bright Bridge.
- Ministries in Pensacola provided gifts & supplies to foster children through Children in Crisis.
- Young widows found support through Crowned for Ashes retreats.
- Supported Anti Human Trafficking education events for the Community with Magdalene's.
- At-risk kids received daily mentoring, meals, & care at Milk and Honey.









Cares Ministry



The Cares Ministry provided a compassionate and consistent presence throughout this year, walking alongside individuals in every season of life.

Celebrate Recovery welcomed 70+ participants weekly for support & healing, with an average of 3 new people each week

16 people graduated CR step studies. Studies are a 9-month commitment to working through life's hurts, habits & hangups.

30+ individuals walked through DivorceCare & GriefShare

The Cares team ministered to 2,500 people this year through prayer, resources, and ministry assistance.










Our Generosity. God's Mission.

Investing in our mission of Connecting People to Jesus




% breakdown of money spent
